

Kruti Dev Matra and Conjunct Chart - Free PDF

Every sequence below is what the Typing Tutor and the converter use. Press the keys left to right.

Sign	Example	Keys to press, in order	Note
ि	कि	[f] then [d]	Typed BEFORE the consonant it belongs to.
ी	की	[d] then [h]	Typed after the consonant.
ु	कु	[d] then [q]	After the consonant.
ू	कू	[d] then [w]	After the consonant.
े	के	[d] then [s]	After the consonant.
ै	कै	[d] then [Shift] + [s]	After the consonant, with Shift.
ो	को	[d] then [k] then [s]	Two keys: the aa-matra, then the e-matra.
ौ	कौ	[d] then [k] then [Shift] + [s]	Two keys: the aa-matra, then the ai-matra.
ं	कं	[d] then [a]	After the syllable, like a matra.
ः	कः	[d] then [Shift] + [5]	After the syllable, with Shift.
ृ	कृ	[d] then [']	After the consonant.
्र	प्र	[i] then [z]	The र under a letter: typed after that letter.
र्	कर्म	[d] then [e] then [Shift] + [z]	The र on top: typed AFTER the whole syllable it sits on.
्	क्य	[Shift] + [d] then [;]	A half letter has its own key, usually the Shift one.
क्ष	क्ष	[Shift] + [l] then [k]	A half क्ष, then the vertical bar.
त्र	त्र	[=]	One key.
ज्ञ	ज्ञ	[Shift] + [k]	One key, with Shift.
श्र	श्र	[Shift] + [j]	One key, with Shift.
ड़	ड़	[Shift] + [m] then [Shift] + [=]	The letter, then the dot.
ज़	ज़	[t] then [Shift] + [=]	The letter, then the dot.
